1. New Forest Association (NFA) objects to this application.
2. This application breaches cornerstone policy CP12 and the Authority has been consistent in refusing such applications under delegated authority and via the Development Control committee even when there is some community advantage (00179 and 00580). There is nothing in the NPPF to support such an application, and it should be noted that National Parks were exempted from The Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 2015 enabling conversion of agricultural buildings to dwelling.
